My teaching experience includes the courses “Political Philosophy” and “Power and Democracy” at University College Maastricht (UCM) and Maastricht University Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences (FASoS), focusing on understanding the history of political philosophy, on the one hand, interrelationships of Europeanisation, international developments, globalization and political change in the EU and in a global context, on the other. The syllabi encompass issues such as democratic imagination, practices and citizenship, political representation, public and private space, Marxist critique and indigenous responses. I am an experienced lecturer both in classroom and online settings. At UCM and FASoS I developed expertise in Problem-based learning (PBL), an innovative student-centred teaching method. More recently (Spring 2022), I taught a course on “Migration/Immigration/Asylum in the Americas” at New York University, and coordinated and taught a laboratory on the “Criminalization of Solidarity” at the University of Deusto, for the Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degree in Human Rights Policy and Practice. Previously, I taught (Fall 2019) a seminar on “Negative Platonism” at the New School for Social Research as a TA for the “Socrates and An-Archic Subjects” Course at the Philosophy Faculty. Following my PhD, I also taught the summer course “Espace politique et apparence” at the XVIII^e Université européenne d’été 2018 (Réseau OFFRES) “Réalité et fiction” at the Cluj-Napoca University in Romania in Summer 2018, as well as two seminars on my dissertation at the Scuola Normale Superiore and Università degli Studi di Roma La Sapienza during Fall Semester 2018. At Columbia, I organized and chaired in Fall 2016 at the Faculty of Philosophy the Frantz Fanon Reading Group Seminar. My teaching philosophy is based upon my conviction that political thinking is a collective act that both gives space to diversity and, at the same time, produces inclusiveness, a common activity that, by bringing people together, converts the classroom into a plural space of participation.
