Work in Progress

Monograph: *The Will to Become: Beauvoir and Nietzsche Against Existentialism*

This book argues that Beauvoir's abandonment of Sartre's idea of ontological freedom leads in her later writings of the 1960s-80s to the complete rejection of the core tenets of existentialism in favor of a determinist, naturalist, and immoralist conception of politics that has important parallels with Nietzsche's political thought.
