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I am a political philosopher working at the intersection of theories of justice, critical theory, and the politics of recognition, with a research recently focused on climate justice and the normative tensions generated by pluralism and public disagreement over the green transition in liberal democracies. Currently, I am a Postdoctoral Researcher at the Department of Political and Social Sciences, University of Catania, where I work on the project "L'influenza della concezione di autonomia morale kantiana nelle teorie politiche contemporanee con particolare riguardo al dibattito sulla giustizia climatica," under the supervision of Prof. Luigi Caranti. Previously, a Post-doctoral Researcher at the Institute of Law, Politics, and Development (DIRPOLIS) at the Sant'Anna School of Advanced Studies (2023-2024), Italy.
