

Antti Hautamäki (b. 1949), PhD, now a professor emeritus, was in years 2009-2013 a research professor of innovation and the director of Agora Center at the University of Jyväskylä. Before that he was in years 1996-2008 the research and executive director at the Finnish Innovation Fund Sitra. He has been an adjunct professor of philosophy at the University of Helsinki from the year 1987. The focuses of his research have been epistemology, philosophical logic, and philosophy of science. Hautamäki has published and edited about thirty books (including *Viewpoint Relativism*, Springer 2020) and published over two hundred articles about philosophy, cognitive science and innovation.
