- “**Phenomenological Perspectives on Mindfulness**” with Ron McClamrock, Ph.D. (*In Draft*): An independent study that investigates advanced aspects of 4E cognition through an existential-phenomenological survey of historical and contemporary authors focusing on a phenomenological concept of “mindfulness.”
- “**Mind & the World: Introduction to Metaphysics & Epistemology**” with Ron McClamrock, Ph.D. (*In Draft*): A comprehensive textbook designed as a companion to undergraduate courses on the philosophical perspectives of metaphysics and epistemology from the stance of one’s interaction of the mind and their everyday world.
